



Wondering what to send?

School Supply Kits for *Operation Dreamseed*

Basic "kits" (packed in 1 1/2 or 2 gallon* zip-type bags or back packs) **include:**

At least 3 pencils and 3 pens
colored pencil set
eraser
pencil sharpener
notebook or three-ring binder filled with lined, blank and/or graph paper
ruler (metric)
glue stick
blunt scissors

Very much appreciated extras:

solar powered calculator
math/geometry sets
stickers
water colors
pencil holder or pouch
simple math practice books
puzzles
coloring or maze books
small toy or craft kit (visual instructions only)
combs, hair brushes, toothbrushes and toothpastes

In addition, for our Soldiers who distribute the kits:

You may want to include pictures, name and address of you and your family or organization as well as a thank you letter and/or goody bag.

- two gallon zip-lock bags can be found at Wal Mart
- 99cent store has calculators and geometry sets and scissors for 99cents
- Wal Mart carries water color sets for under \$1

What should NOT be included:

*Please do **not** enclose any religious materials (this would include coloring books depicting Biblical stories or holidays.)

*Political messages should also not be included.

* Books in English are not useful for the students.

*Many of today's cartoons depict characters that show bare midriffs, etc. These would be offensive to the Islamic faith and therefore we ask that you do not send folders or coloring books with these types of pictures
